Using technology, each tree is geotagged by the planter allowing us and the planter to follow their tree.

Women and children are a key target group for this project being that they spend the most time in smoky kitchens and are responsible for collection and/or purchase of wood fuel. The improved cookstoves also address deforestation as a key issue regionally, through increased energy efficiency and alternative biomass energy sources that will be highlighted showing how rural communities are enhancing adaptation measures and building their resilience to climate change.
